



REPORT ON TWINNING OF SCHOOLS



With reference to the Letter no. 353/SC-ST/2024 of Samagra Shiksha, Ganjam dated 02/02/2024 regarding twinning of elementary Schools with Odisha Adarsha Vidyalayas /Headquarter High Schools, an exposure visit was organised on 21st February, 2024 with 52 students from Govindapur UPS to OAV Pakidi Hill, Sheragada, Ganjam. Under this programme, the students of class V, VI, VII and VIII of Govindapur UPS participated in the class rooms transaction at OAV Sheragada. They also visited the E-library, Computer Lab and Science laboratories (Physics, Chemistry, Biology).
