The Entrance Test is conducted by Board of Secondary Education, Odisha, Cuttack on 09.01.2024 at 704 centres for taking admission into Odisha Adarsha Vidvalava (OAV) and Odisha Mining Adarsha Vidvalava (OMAV) in Class VI, lateral entry into Class VII, VIII & IX in OAVs and lateral entry into Class VII in OMAVs for the session 2024-25. The total number of candidates registered for the Entrance Test is 1.49.173. The Entrance Test conducted successfully by the BSE, Odisha, Cuttack and OAVS Bhubaneswar. The number of candidates appearing for the Entrance Test is increasing year by year due to best educational infrastructure and facilities provided by the government of Odisha to OAVs. The result of the Entrance Test will be published by the BSE, Odisha, Cuttack.

Participation in Pariksha Pe Charcha 2024








Acheivement in Hockey in District level Nua-o-Sports Competition
